On September 17, 2010, DOE FOIA Counsel, Patrick Burke, sent you a letter informing you that the fee estimate of costs related to your subject FOIA request is \$200. In that letter, he indicated that should you wish to proceed with your FOIA request, you must provide us with your agreement to pay the estimated cost. It has been almost two weeks since Mr. Burke sent that letter, and we have not heard from you relative to your agreement to pay fees. Because we cannot hold FOIA requests open indefinitely, we are closing your file for inactivity. However, should you wish to pursue the records you were seeking, please notify me in writing and express your willingness to pay the fee estimate of \$200, and I will open a new FOIA request and process it within the FOIA guidelines.
