**SUBJECT: U.S. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY (DOE) OFFICE OF SCIENCE – CHICAGO OFFICE (SC-CH) FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT (FOIA) REQUEST NO. CH-10-02**

I am the authorizing official responsible for making the determination required by Section 1004.5(b) of DOE regulations found at 10 CFR Part 1004, implementing the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. 552.

On October 26, 2009, I forwarded to you SC-CH's response to your original FOIA request #CH-10-01 in which you were seeking "information (emails and/or other correspondence to/from/cc DOE-Berkeley official Gary Drew) regarding DOE-PNSO employee Don E. Moody" to include "all emails [with all attachments], hardcopy memos, and any other documents [electronic and/or hardcopy] that pertain to Phillip Pulver and/or his company Catalogs OnLine Inc. [aka/dba Custom Catalogs OnLine Inc., CCOL, CCOL-MDM & Mobile Data Methods Inc.]." In our response, I indicated that any responsive records maintained by Gary Drew would be under the records jurisdiction of DOE's Oak Ridge Office (ORO) and would be processed by that office.

In your e-mail of October 21, 2009, you broadened your above mentioned original request to include "emails and/or other correspondence to/from/cc SC-CH officials Roxanne E. Purucker – Chicago Site Manager; Alan Handwerker – Office of Chief Counsel – Chicago; and Deputy Chief Counsel – Mark Dvorscak – Chicago." I indicated in my October 26, 2009 response to your request #CH-10-01 that I opened new request #CH-10-02 to address the additional records you were seeking, i.e., records of Roxanne E. Purucker, Alan Handwerker, and Mark Dvorscak, and would respond to the new request under separate cover. This letter represents our final response to request #CH-10-02 for those additional records.

In response to request #CH-10-02, be advised that we have conducted a search of records maintained by Roxanne E. Purucker, Alan Handwerker, and Mark Dvorscak, and have located no records responsive to your request.

You are advised of your right to appeal the adequacy of our search for your requested information within 30 days of receipt of this letter by writing to the Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, United States Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20585. Both the request and envelope should be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Appeal." Judicial review will be available thereafter in the district in which your concern is located or has its principal place of business, where the records are located, or in the District of Columbia.

You have been categorized as a "Commercial Use" requester, and as such, you would normally be subject to fee assessment for search time and duplication costs. However, pursuant to our granting you a fee waiver, we are not assessing fees for this request.
