I am the authorizing official responsible for making the determination required by Section 1004.5(b) of DOE regulations found at 10 CFR Part 1004, implementing the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. 552. This letter is in final response to your subject FOIA request.

In your original FOIA request you were seeking "ANL Report ANL-6077, the operating instructions for the Argonne Low Power Reactor." In your subsequent e-mail of June 30, 2010, you narrowed your FOIA request to "the front matter of ANL-6077" more specifically, "the cover, abstract/executive summary, table of contents, purpose, distribution list (for this report it may just be a reference to TID-4500), acknowledgements and authors."

Be advised that we searched our offices and located no responsive documents. We also requested that the DOE contractor that operates Argonne National Laboratory (ANL), UChicago Argonne LLC (UCA), conduct a search for responsive records. UCA conducted their search of ANL and located the enclosed responsive records, which were maintained in microcard format. You will note that some portions of the records may be illegible. This is the condition in which the record exists on the microcard so we are unable to provide you with a more legible version. The records we are providing to you are the only records responsive to your narrowed FOIA request, and therefore, this response represents our full release of records for your request.

You are categorized as an "Other" requester, and as such related costs for search and duplication of records are applicable under FOIA.
